# TREATMENT OF FRINGE BENEFITS:

OFF-CAMPUS DEFINITION: For all activities performed in facilities not owned by the institution and to which rent is directly allocated to the project(s), the off-campus rate will apply. Actual costs will be apportioned between on-campus and off-campus components. Each portion will bear the appropriate rate.

# SECTION III: GENERAL

### A. <u>LIMITATIONS:</u>

The rates in this Agreement are subject to any statutory or administrative limitations and apply to a given grant, contract or other agreement only to the extent that funds are available. Acceptance of the rates is subject to the following conditions: (1) Only costs incurred by the organization were included in its facilities and administrative cost principles; (2) The same costs that have been treated as facilities and administrative costs are not claimed as direct to organization which was used to establish the rates is not later found to be materially incomplete or inaccurate by the Government. In such situations the rate(s) would be subject to renegotiation at the discretion of the Federal

#### B. ACCOUNTING CHANGES:

This Agreement is based on the accounting system purported by the organization to be in effect during the Agreement period. Changes to the method of accounting for costs which affect the amount of reimbursement resulting from the use of this Agreement require prior approval of the authorized representative of the cognizant agency. Such changes include, but Failure to obtain approval may result in cost disallowances.
