Subject: BWH FY22 Fringe Benefit and Indirect Cost Rates

I am writing to provide an update on the FY22 Fringe Benefit Rate and Indirect Cost Rates that will be applied on BWH research funds, effective October 1, 2021.

Fringe Benefit Rates

The FY22 Fringe Benefit Rates for Professional Staff-MD's will increase to 31% and Fellows will increase to 34%. While the FY23 fringe benefit rates will not be established until next September based on updated known costs, we are recommending that grant budgets for future years incorporate the following multi-year fringe rate assumptions.

Indirect Cost Rates

The federal <u>rate agreement</u> rates (per rate agreement dated September 28th, 2020) are reflected in the table below. They will be applied to all BWH research grants (and some contracts) effective October 1, 2021 and should be used in all contract, grant and subcontract proposals submitted to extramural sponsors.

Grants or contracts will not be subject to more than one indirect cost rate. If more than 50% of a project is performed off-site, the off-site rate will apply to the entire project.
